Minutes

- Action Item: Approve September 13, 2023 meeting minutes as presented by CC: MD moved, RG seconded. Passed unanimously with JS and CC abstaining.

Finance Committee

- Financials of September 30, 2023 presented by KK
 - Expenses were as expected for the month.
 - **Action item:** Accept financials as presented: PT moved, MK seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- Discussion of preliminary budget for 2024
 - The preliminary budget is increasing by 1.3% from last year, not including COLA or healthcare cost increases.
 - **Action Item:** Approve preliminary budget for 2024: JM moved, NB seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- 2022 auditor report from PKF O'Connor Davies update presented by KK
 - PKF provided clarification that no evidence of fraud was identified. The clarification will be kept on file.
 - The report was accepted by Town Supervisor Daniel McLaughlin and was submitted to the office of the NY State Comptroller

- Flooding during last month's rains not as bad as anticipated given the amount of precipitation

 - 134 children out of 205 new kindergarteners in Pelham received their Library cards during K-Day.

 - The Library will be collaborating with Pelham Together on a program for middle and/or high school students.
